

PSALM 91



Inspired by... God The Father,
The Son, and The Holy Spirit



Curvis and Bess dwells in the shelter of the Most High and Curvis and Bess abides in the shadow of the Almighty. Curvis and Bess says to the Lord, "My Refuge and My Fortress, Our God, in whom we trust!" For it is God who delivers Curvis and Bess from the snare of the trapper and from the deadly pestilence [fatal, infectious disease]. God will cover Curvis and Bess with His pinions, and under His wings Curvis and Bess may seek refuge; God's faithfulness is a shield and bulwark.

Curvis and Bess will not be afraid of the terror by night, or of the arrow that flies by day; of the pestilence that stalks in darkness, or of the destruction that lays waste at noon.
